2. **arithmetic** / ə'ɪθ.mə.tɪk/ n the part of mathematics that involves the adding and multiplying, etc. of numbers

I've never been very good at arithmetic.

She was taught reading, writing and arithmetic at the village school.

3. **characterize** / 'kær.əktə.raɪz / v to describe something by stating its main qualities

The group was characterized as being well-educated.

4. **commercial** //kə'mɜːʃəl/ adj related to buying and selling things

A product as good as that is a guarantee of commercial success

5. **distribute** /dɪ'strɪb.ju:t/ v to give something out to several people

The books will be distributed free to local schools.

Their teacher distributed a review for the exam.

6. **evolve** / ɪ'vɒlv/ v to develop gradually

Most languages are constantly evolving and changing, which is what keeps them alive.

The company has evolved over the years into a multi-million-dollar organization.

7. **horizon** / hə'raɪzən/ n the line at the farthest place that you can see, where the sky seems to touch the land or sea

Do you think those are rain clouds on the horizon?

I hoped that going to university might broaden my horizons.

8. **transform** / træns'fɔ:m/ v to change completely the appearance or character of something or someone

The new haircut completely transformed her.

Since getting that job, he has been a transformed character.

9. **sequence** / 'si:.kwəns / n a series of related things or events

Is there a particular sequence in which you have to perform these tasks?

You had to put the numbers into the right sequence.

10. **widespread** / waɪd'spred/ adj existing or happening in many places and/or among many people

The next 36 hours will be even colder with snow showers becoming more widespread.
